

**Mansfield Fish & Game Protective Association, Inc.**  
**Policy Regarding The Use of Class III/Title II/NFA Firearms and Devices**

- 1) When adopted, this policy shall replace the one approved by the BOD on Oct 31, 2018.
- 2) Only lawfully owned and possessed Class III/Title II/NFA Firearms and Devices are allowed on the property of Mansfield Fish and Game. The appropriate Federal and State proof of lawful ownership and possession must be present for all items. This paperwork must be presented to any club official requesting it. Inability to provide the proper paperwork will result in the immediate expulsion from the club property.  
**There are no exceptions.**
- 3) All standard range rules, regulations, and range etiquette shall continue to apply for the use of Class III/Title II/NFA Firearms and Devices on Mansfield Fish & Game property. Additionally:
  - a. Full automatic fire is permissible on each of the ranges.
  - b. All full automatic fire must be as close to the berm as necessary to assure no bullets leave the club property.
  - c. The 50 yard range is the preferred range for this activity due to the higher berm.
- 4) The possession and use of firearms capable of full automatic fire on Mansfield Fish & Game property is restricted to **authorized members of MF&G in good standing** who have a **valid** Massachusetts License To Possess OR possess valid FFL with SOT allowing legal possession. *There is no provision for guests to participate in this activity.*
- 5) The use of firearms capable of full automatic fire shall be considered a **privilege** as granted on a case by case basis per the BOD. It is further noted that such privilege may be revoked by the BOD at any time, effective immediately, and without specified cause.
- 6) The BOD shall appoint a representative who will advise the BOD to either grant, deny, or revoke a members application/priviledge to have firearms capable of full automatic fire on club property. A member receiving a negative recommendation may appeal it to the BOD.
- 7) A member wishing to use a firearm capable of full automatic fire on club property must appear before the BODs' appointed representative and demonstrate the following competency using a target set as close to the berm as is necessary for safety:
  - a. Can determine how close to the berm is necessary to avoid bullets leaving club property.

- b.** Demonstrate the ability to safely load and unload the firearm under normal conditions and when stoppages occur.
  - c.** Demonstrate basic marksmanship skills using the firearm in semiautomatic mode if applicable or with 1-3 rounds loaded for each demonstration.
  - d.** Demonstrate the ability to fire a controlled 3 to 5 round burst into an appropriate target with a reasonable group.
  
- 8)** A member who has been qualified to use firearms capable of full automatic fire will receive different photoID badge clearly identifying they have been granted this privilege.
  
- 9)** **Members who have this privilege revoked are responsible for the immediate return of their full auto badge to the club Purser. A member who does not immediately return their full auto badge will have their FOB deactivated and shall be subject to any disciplinary action deemed appropriate by the Board of Directors.**
